

License to inclusion and publication of a Bachelor or Master Thesis in the Leiden University Student Repository

Leiden University (hereafter also “University”) has set up a digital repository via which Theses produced by its Students in the context of their studies will be archived and made available online. This will facilitate the processes of creating, acquiring, sharing and advancing knowledge within the education sector.

- Uploading the Thesis to the Student Repository is mandatory by virtue of the Course and Examination Regulations.
- Theses will be stored in the Repository for at least 10 years. This License Agreement defines the terms and conditions regarding storage and use.
- To publish (part of) a Thesis, temporarily or permanently, the consent is required of the Student, the Supervisor and, if applicable, the (external) client. This is laid down in the Consent Form for the Publication of a Thesis provided by the Study Programme and to be filled in and signed by all parties.

Rights and obligations of the Student

- The copyright of the Thesis remains with the Student once it is included in the Student Repository.
- The Student grants the University a free and non-exclusive licence to include the Student’s Thesis in the Student Repository, to store and preserve it for at least 10 years, and keep it accessible for the future.
- The Student allows the University to grant access to the Thesis at all times by the inspection committee that judges the quality of the Study Programme for which the Student has written the Thesis.
- If the Student, by means of the above mentioned Form, has given consent to publication in the Leiden Repository, the Student also grants the University the right to make the Thesis available to Users worldwide. The Student may withdraw consent at any time. The Student also grants the University the right to alter or restrict access to the Thesis if there are compelling reasons to do so.
- The Student permits Users to download the Thesis under the conditions mentioned below (“Rights and obligations of the User”).
- In case the Student has incorporated in the Thesis material created by third parties that is still in copyright: the Student declares that consent was given by the copyright holder to incorporate this material in the Thesis.

Rights and obligations of the University

- This non-exclusive licence granted by the Student permits the University to include the Thesis in the Student Repository, to store and to preserve it for at least 10 years, and to keep it accessible for the future.

- The University shall store the Thesis in its original form. The University is entitled to make copies of the Thesis and, if necessary to alter the format, to ensure permanent preservation and future consultation. In doing so, the University shall do everything that is reasonably possible to respect the technical functionality, design, and content of the Thesis.
- The University has the right at all times to grant access to the Thesis by the inspection committee that judges the quality of the Study Programme for which the Student has written the Thesis.
- If the Student, by means of the above mentioned Form, has given consent to publication in the Leiden Repository, the University is permitted to make the Thesis available to Users worldwide under the conditions mentioned below (“Rights and obligations of the User”).
- The University has the right to alter or restrict access to the Student’s Thesis if there are compelling reasons to do so.
- The University has the right to remove personal names/information from the Thesis if (inter)national privacy law so requires and/or when there are (other) compelling reasons to do so.

Rights and obligations of the User

- Downloading is strictly limited to personal use and study. Any other use such as, but not limited to, copying, distributing, sale, loan, transfer, lease, provision, placing on a website or other digital platform, is permitted only with the Student’s prior written permission.
